GUIDELINES FOR PAPERS PREPARATION FOR BLACK SEA 2024 TITLE OF THE PAPER EACH

First AUTHOR*, Second AUTHOR** and Third AUTHOR*

(family name, name, surname of each author)

* Affiliation of the first author

**Affiliation of the second author, if different from the above, including organization name

Abstract. The present sample contains information on preparation of the digests for the XVII-th International Conference on Marine Scienses and Technologies BLACK SEA 2024, which will be held from 17 to 18 of October 2024 in Varna, Bulgaria. The abstract should contain the most important information about the paper. Please avoid citations and symbols other than normal text.

Keywords: Up to five, in alphabetical order.

INTRODUCTION

These instructions are written using Microsoft Word 2003. You can also use other versions of Microsoft Word like 97, 2000 or later.

The length of the paper should be 6 pages. The page setup should be in such a way that on A4 paper the margins are: top margin 2.5 cm, bottom margin 2 cm, left margin 2.5 cm and right margin 2.5 cm. Do not number the pages. The proceedings will be printed in A4 format.

PAPER ATTRIBUTES

Fonts and styles

It is recommended to use Times New Roman font or equivalent. The title, authors, affiliation, headings, table captions and figure captions are centered. Subheadings are left aligned. Left indent of the subheadings and the first line indent is 1.25 cm. Abstract and Keywords have 2 cm left and right indent. References should be numbered using "Numbering", to have 0.75 cm hanging first line and the first tab set at 0.75 cm.

The font sizes and appearance for the styles to be used in the full paper are shown in Table 1.

Figures, tables and equations

Tables can be created using "Table | Insert table" command. It is not recommended to split the table over two pages. Table caption should be over the table, as in Table 1.




Figure 1. This is the figure caption for centred figure.

Figures should be centered and figure captures placed below the figures, as in Fig. 1. In case of very small figures, where text wrapping is necessary, figures can be placed either left or right. It is recommended that the box "Float over text" for the figure position be not checked.

Equations should be centered and numbered flush left, as in Eqn. 1. They can be part of the sentence, like in the electromagnetic field equation written in the form

$$(1) \nabla \times (\nu \nabla \times A \rightarrow) - J \rightarrow e + \sigma (\partial A \rightarrow) / \partial t - \sigma \nu \rightarrow B \rightarrow - \nabla \times (\nu \mu_0 M \rightarrow) = 0$$

All symbols used in the equations should be defined either before or right after the equation.

All references should be numbered in square brackets both in the list of references and when citing them [1]. For books [2], use *italic* for the book title. When the book or paper is not in English, give the English translation of the title and specify the language in parentheses at the end.

CONCLUSIONS

Please pay attention to the language. If your native language is not English, please get a native English-speaking colleague to proofread your paper. Employing UK spell checker is recommended.
